- **Year 7 Head Boy & Girl and Deputy Head Boy and Girl, visiting schools – Monday 27th June or Tuesday 28th June**

This visit will enable your child to meet members of staff from the Middle School including Mrs Goss (Acting Deputy Head Teacher), Miss Smith (Head of Year 5) and Mrs Barker (SENCO). They will also be accompanied by our Head Boy and Girl and their Deputies. They will learn about life at St Nicholas from a staff and child's perspective as well as have the opportunity to ask any questions that they may have.

- **Transition Day 1 at SNMS – Friday 1st July & Transition Day 2 at SNMS – Monday 4th July**

The transition days provide the perfect opportunity for your child to experience life at St Nicholas.
