- 2:00-3:00pm - Friends of Pinvin Refreshments (sweets/ice cream/ice lollies/cream teas/hot and cold drinks) & School Tombola/Games on the Playground – all proceeds towards Year 4 and Year 7 leavers events
- 2:30pm - Parents/Carers able to take children home via signing out at the front office at SNMS
- 3:00pm - Remaining pupil's back to class for end of day

Please bring your own picnic blankets and chairs, as well as your own food and soft drinks to enjoy with your family and friends - we do kindly ask that no nuts are brought onto the premises. As we will have 300+ school children around the outside area, if you do attend, we would hugely appreciate if you were to keep a close eye on your own children at the event. If children have brought a lunchbox to school, then they can join you outside with these at the allocated time. If children are to consume school dinners provided by school, this will still continue and these will be able to be eaten outside as well. If you are unavailable to join us, children will be provided with places to sit and enjoy their lunch.

Do bring along some change as the Friends of Pinvin (PTA) will be selling hot and cold drinks and supporting Year 4 with selling ice lollies/ice creams. Year 7 will be selling their own freshly made scones (plain & fruit) with a choice of cream, butter and jam. The Head Boys and Girls of both schools, alongside their Deputies will also be running a sweet stand.

On **Friday 20th May** we will be holding a non-uniform day and in return we will be asking pupils to bring in an item of choice which is either red, blue, white or silver in colour, for the tombola, which will be run by our Prefects.

All proceeds from the event will go towards end of year activities for the children.

To mark the commemorative event, Friends of Pinvin have purchased a medal for each child which has been engraved on the back to serve as a reminder in years to come. As well as this, keep your eyes peeled for more information coming your way on school tea towels which will be available to purchase as another reminder for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee to help raise funds towards our school.
