## **Food and Drink**

It is a long day, so please ensure your child has a good breakfast before they come to school. They will need to bring **two** meals with them to school, ideally in separate lunchboxes. We will have an early lunch before we leave and eat our dinner in the break between rehearsal and concert. Please also ensure they have a couple of **healthy snacks** and a **refillable water bottle**.

**If your child normally has a free school lunch provided, and you would like your child to have a packed lunch provided that day, then please ensure you let the school office know your child's packed lunch choice (tuna/cheese/ham). Please note you will still need to ensure they have a packed dinner with them (to eat at the venue).**

## **Clothes**

Children need to wear their **school uniform** throughout the day. For the concert, children will need to wear their **Young Voices** t-shirt (if ordered) or a **white t-shirt**. It makes sense for children to wear their t-shirt under their jumper, so all they need to do is take off their jumper for the concert. We don't want any food down our lovely performance clothes!

## **Collection**

After the concert, we will be returning to school in the coach. This is the safest way to end the day. Our estimated arrival time is 22.30 for collection from school. We will send a text when we are on the way, so that you have an updated arrival time for you to collect your child.

## **Audience Tickets and T-shirts**

**Audience tickets and T-shirts are at school and will be available for collection from Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May.** Please come and collect them from the school office, to prevent any going missing or lost in school bags! If you are unable to do this, simply email the school office to say you are happy for your child to take them home.

**As it will have been a long day and a late night, your child is welcome to come in a bit later to school on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> May at 9.45am so they are ready for Lesson 2.**
