### **YEAR 7 SCIENCE TRIP – THINK TANK, BIRMINGHAM (THURSDAY, 31<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2022)**

We are excited to be able to invite all of our Year 7 pupils to join us on a one-day trip to Think Tank in Birmingham on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> March. The trip will be during the hours of a normal school day.

The children will attend a workshop called “The Science of Sport”; this links to the science unit of work on forces and is PE related. In this lively and interactive show, they will use sports to explain the scientific principles of forces and energy. The children will test their reactions, learn how to sumo wrestle, demonstrate inertia, and play crazy cricket to demonstrate friction.
