Covid-19 cases at Pinvin Federation

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are currently experiencing an increasing number of positive Covid cases across St Nicholas Middle School. School transport remains a major factor in cases spreading, so if you are able to avoid using them in the short term please do so. We understand some parents do not have a choice in this matter.

We would advise that children are tested regularly using Lateral Flow tests at home before coming in to school. If your child presents any of the symptoms (temperature of 38.0 or higher, persistent cough and/or loss of taste or smell) please do not send your child in to school and book them in for a PCR test as soon as possible.

Please ensure you keep the school office informed of any positive tests or if you have booked your child in for a PCR, including details such as any symptoms and when they started or when a positive test was taken. We are required to complete daily updates for the Government so it is imperative all information is correct.

Recent guidance states that children do not need to wear masks in classrooms from the 20th January and in all communal areas from 27th January. We would however recommend children continue to wear masks, if they want to, while we have a high amount of cases.

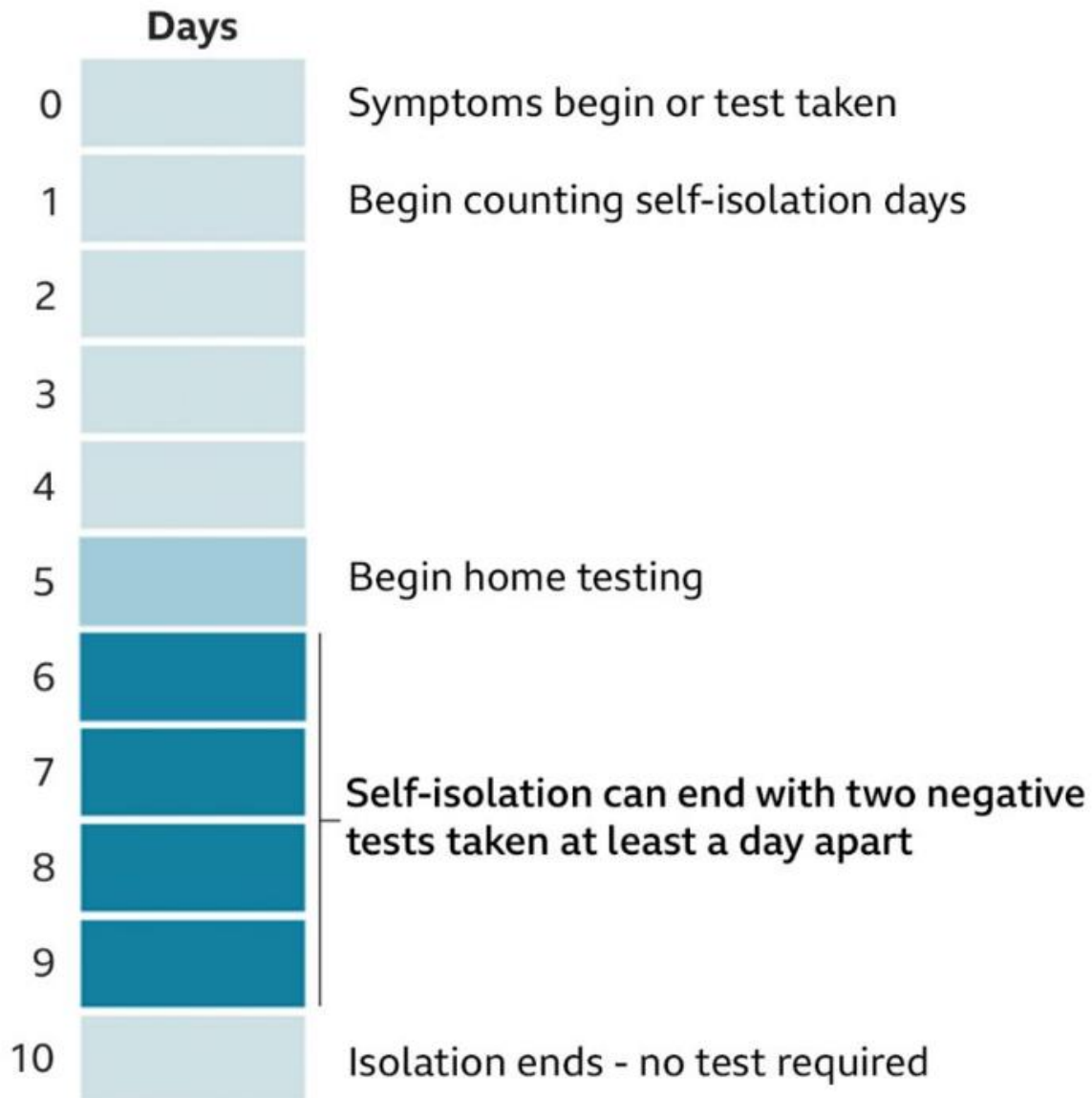
