YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO INGESTRE HALL, STAFFORDSHIRE (WEDNESDAY 8TH – FRIDAY 10TH JUNE 2022)

We would like to invite all Year 6 pupils on an exciting new residential trip for 2 nights during the summer term from Wednesday 8th - Friday 10th June 2022.

We will be staying at the Ingestre Hall Residential Arts Centre in Staffordshire, a 400-year old Jacobean mansion creating a dramatic backdrop for creative and expressive arts. This exciting residential is a trip unlike any they have experienced before. The children can try different techniques in art, dance and drama, music and lots more to create, record and perform. They can try out exciting activities like animation, recording music, creating artwork such as pictures and sculptures, or creating a dance. The venue has professionally equipped studios, including a recording studio, live performance space and animation suites. The centre is situated within 26 acres of landscaped gardens, providing plenty of safe space to play.

The total cost per child will be £180 which includes the venue fees as well as transport to and from Ingestre Hall. **All payments must be made online via ParentPay as follows (£180 total cost):**

1. **£20 non-refundable deposit by 29th October 2021 (Note: fully refundable in the event of COVID)**
2. £30 instalment by 30th November 2021
3. £30 instalment by 31st January 2022
4. £50 instalment by 28th February 2022
5. £50 instalment by 31st March 2022

Please also complete the following information online in ParentPay (against this payment item):

- Consent for your child to attend the trip and take part in the activities.
- Emergency contact details.
- Medical/allergy/dietary details.
- Photo consent.
- Travel sickness (and any prevention arrangements).
- Any other information (e.g. homesickness, bed-wetting, significant bedtime routine).
- Consent for emergency medical/dental/surgical treatment as considered necessary by the medical authorities present.

This trip has to be funded by parent contributions and will only go ahead if we have enough children wanting to go. Please note that we are no longer able to offer pupil premium funding for trips.
