Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday 22nd February, we are looking forward to welcoming all the children back to school.

The expectation is that all schools will reopen from 8th March 2021. We have planned a staggered return so that we can ensure we have offered testing to all Year 7 pupils. This is essential to ensure that we are able to reopen to all pupils safely and reduce the number of asymptomatic cases on site. We also need to ensure that testing is conducted in a safe and controlled manner with health and safety at the heart of any decisions made. The timetable of the planned return is included at the end of this letter. Please note, Year 7 children will continue to access learning remotely until their day of return.

The other important change is that the use of face coverings in classrooms and on the school site for **ALL** Year 7 children and staff is mandatory and attendance on site will be mandatory for **ALL** pupils unless they are Clinically Extremely Vulnerable (CEV) and have a shielding letter from their GP.

Year 7 parents - Consent forms for testing need to be returned to the office asap, if you haven't already done so, please return by Friday 26.02.21 to allow us to be safely prepared. If your child has already been testing in school as a critical worker, you do not need to submit another form.

Over the next few days we will continue to monitor guidance and review all other arrangements. Please be aware that further instruction with regard to procedures in school, transport times etc will be forwarded to all parents early next week. Please be assured that we will continue to proceed with care and caution over the next few weeks to ensure the safety of all. Thank you all for your continued support and fingers crossed that we are on our way to some kind of 'normality'.
